KNOTT'S BERRY FARM

To add to the fun, we have scheduled a trip to Knott's Berry Farm on November 10.

We chose November 10 because Knott's has made several changes their Veteran Appreciation program. The Military discount program only runs Monday through Thursday and is only the first two weeks of November and the first two weeks of December. We chose the 10th to get the visit after the Chapter meeting and further into the month of November so folks can plan for the event.

Also, Knott's changed the pricing structure. It used to be the vet and guest were free and a discounted ticket price was offered for four additional guests. Now it's just \$20 a head for military or deceased military's spouse and 5 guests. "Active, Retired, and Veteran U.S. Military Personnel may receive discounted admission to Knott's Berry Farm for themselves and up to 5 guests during Military Tribute Days. Tickets can be purchased online for \$19.99 (plus taxes and fees) at Knotts.com or at the Knott's Berry Farm ticket booths. Spouses of deceased military personnel may purchase discounted admission for themselves and up to five additional discounted tickets by providing a Military Spouse ID."

As we have done in the past, we will meet at 10:00 am by the flagpole located in front of the ticket booths. Once in the park, you are welcome to stay as long as you want up to closing. Don't forget that parking is additional.
