The following is an update about George Neuman from his children Debbie, Jeff and Mike.

George turned 90 last year and has been healthy from the virus. However, his memory and eyesight are a challenge. He had to give up driving, which, as you can imagine, was not easy. Jeff helped tremendously with mail, finances and doctor appointments. Although Jeff lives in Santa Rosa, he made monthly drives to Southern California.

Last April, George moved out of his apartment in Costa Mesa and into Emerald Court Independent Living in Santa Ana. Unfortunately, he was not able to be independent, so a caregiver was hired. As luck would have it, in November they received a call from Jackie's board and care home (which houses six people) and was invited to take a room that had become available. George joined Jackie at the Cameo Assisted Living in Corona Del Mar. It's wonderful that they can be together. They're getting outstanding care.

Physically, George is doing well. His greatest challenge is losing sight from macular degeneration. But mentally, he's lost a lot of ground. His mother passed from Alzheimer's, and at 90, George's dementia seems to be following in her footsteps. Jackie is hanging in there, continually weaker, but alert and oriented.

George no longer uses his cell phone, computer or email. If you would like to reach him, you may call the landline for Cameo, 949-644-2740. He probably won't talk more than a few minutes, but he'll appreciate the call. Or send a card. The street address follows.
